UNITED STATES ARMY OPERATIONAL
TEST AND EVALUATION COMMAND

1. Effective 15 November 1990, the U.S. Army Operational Test and Evaluation Agency (OTEA) (SFW3Q2AA), a Field Operating Agency (FOA) of Headquarters, Department of the Army, Office, Chief of Staff, Army, was REDESIGNATED as the U.S. Army Operational Test and Evaluation Command (OPTEC) (SFW3Q2AA).


2. Effective 15 November 1990, the U.S. Army Test and Experimentation Command (TEXCOM) (TCW27RAA) was DISESTABLISHED as a subordinate command of the U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC). The mission, functions, personnel and all remaining assets of TEXCOM are transferred to OPTEC.
