REASSIGNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY PERSONNEL INTEGRATION COMMAND AND USA ESCORT DETACHMENT, DAFB TO THE UNITED STATES TOTAL ARMY PERSONNEL COMMAND (PERSCOM)

- 1. Effective 1 October 1991, The United States Army Personnel Integration Command (USAPIC), derivative UIC TCW1EX06, is reassigned from the U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC) to the U.S. Total Army Personnel Command (PERSCOM), and redesignated as the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel Integration. Following publication of this order, the current USAPIC derivative UIC will be disestablished and derivative UIC W3VS50 established. This General Order supersedes previous Permanent Orders, 136–009, dated 14 November 1989, only as it applies to reassignment.
- 2. Effective 1 October 1991, the U.S. Army Escort Detachment, UIC FCW2KFAA, is reassigned from the U.S. Army Forces Command (FORSCOM) to the Adjutant General Directorate of the U.S. Total Army Personnel Command (PERSCOM). Following publication of this order, the current U.S. Army Escort Detachment UIC will be disestablished and derivative UIC W3VS19 established. This General Order supersedes previous General Orders 482, dated 19 March 1974, only as it applies to reassignment.
