## Establishment of the U.S. Army Information Mission Area (IMA) Integration and Analysis Center (IIAC)

- 1. Effective 1 January 1992, the U.S. Army Information Mission Area (IMA) Integration and Analysis Center (IIAC), was established as a staff support agency under the Office of the Director of Information Systems for Command, Control, Communications, and Computers (DISC4). The IIAC will perform the following functions:
- a. Ensure integrated, interoperable, and coherent information (IMA) support for all Army missions through use of information engineering methodologies.
- b. Ensure the effective and efficient management of IMA by providing analytical support to the DISC4.
- 2. The U.S. Army Information Mission Area (IMA) Integration and Analysis Center (IIAC), will be located at the Melpar Building, Arlington, Virginia. Personnel assigned will work under the oversight of the DISC4.
- 3. Administrative support and equipment will be provided by the Software Development Center, Washington, U.S. Army Integration Systems Command.
