

**I—UNITED STATES ARMY GARRISON (WOXQ05)---DISCONTINUED.** Effective 30 September 1998 the United States Army Garrison at Fort Indiantown Gap, Pennsylvania, is discontinued as an active Army organization in accordance with the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1990, Public Law 101-510, as amended and the 1995 recommendations of the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Commission.

**II—FORT INDIANTOWN GAP (42305)---INACTIVATION.** Effective 30 September 1998, Fort Indiantown Gap, Pennsylvania is inactivated as an Active Army Installation in accordance with the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1990, Public Law 101-510, as amended and the 1995 recommendations of the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Commission.

**III—FORT INDIANTOWN GAP TRAINING CENTER (FIGTC), PENNSYLVANIA (42308)---ACTIVATION AND ASSIGNMENT.** Effective 1 October 1998, the Fort Indiantown Gap Training Center (FIGTC), Pennsylvania, an Armed Forces Reserve Component enclave is activated in accordance with the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1990, Public Law 101-510, as amended and the 1995 recommendations of the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Commission, and is assigned to the Chief, National Guard Bureau, Washington, DC.
