HEADQUARTERS DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY WASHINGTON, DC, 1 December 2000

ESTABLISHMENT OF THE DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF FOR PROGRAMS (DCSPRO)

- 1. This confirms the establishment of the position of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Programs (DCSPRO) as an element of the Army Staff (ARSTAF). This also confirms the disestablishment of the Assistant Vice Chief of Staff of the Army.
- 2. Effective 1 December 2000, the Deputy Chief of Staff for Programs (DCSPRO) (CSW6APAA) is established as an Army Staff agency within the Headquarters, Department of the Army. The DCSPRO will perform the following missions subject to the authority, direction, and control of the Secretary of the Army, and under the direction of the responsible office within the Army Secretariat. The DCSPRO will execute approved materiel requirements. The DCSPRO will perform other duties designated by the Chief of Staff of the Army and assist the Vice Chief of Staff of the Army (VCSA) as the Army's representative on the Joint Requirements Oversight Council (JROC) and the Program Review Group (PRG) of the Office of the Secretary of Defense. Pursuant to the direction of the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Financial Management and Comptroller), the DCSPRO will assist in integrating military requirements into the overall programming process.
- 3. Effective 1 December 2000, the Directorate of Program Analysis and Evaluation and the Office of Quadrennial Defense Review (QDR) are assigned to the DCSPRO.
- 4. Effective 1 December 2000, the Force Development Directorate, less the Force Programs Directorate, is assigned to the DCSPRO.
