REDESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY ACQUISITION EXECUTIVE SUPPORT AGENCY (AAESA) TO THE UNITED STATES ARMY ACQUISITION SUPPORT CENTER (ASC)

1. Effective 1 October 2002, the U.S. Army Acquisition Executive Support Agency (AAESA) (W27PAA) is formally REDESIGNATED as the U.S. Army Acquisition Support Center (ASC) (W27PAA), a staff support agency under the Office of the Army Acquisition Executive (AAE), Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Acquisition, Logistics and Technology (ASA(ALT)), Headquarters, Department of the Army. The ASC will perform the following support functions:

Program Executive Office manpower and personnel resource support.

Acquisition Corps management support.

Acquisition Information Management support.

Acquisition Career Program management support.

These functions were previously performed by the AAESA and its component parts. The number of program executive offices is not dependent upon this General Order. All manpower and dollar resources associated with AAESA and its affiliated units (Operating Agencies 5D, 5E, 5F, 5L, 5Q, 5R, 5T, 5X, 5Y, 5Z) are transferred to ASC.

2. This confirms that on 26 October 2001, certain offices within the Army Materiel Command (AMC), Deputies for Systems Acquisition (DSA), were TRANSFERRED from AMC to the ASC as noted in the respective transition plans addressing each DSA, with the authorizations and funding agreed to by the participating commands.
