## RELOCATION AND REASSIGNMENT OF U.S. ARMY SOUTH (USARSO)

- 1. Effective 30 September 2003, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, United States Army South (UIC: WNAGAA), is relocated from Fort Buchanan, Puerto Rico, to Fort Sam Houston, Texas. Personnel and equipment authorizations of Headquarters and Headquarters Company, United States Army South, will remain assigned to Headquarters and Headquarters Company, United States Army South (UIC: WNAGAA), Fort Sam Houston, Texas.
- 2. Effective 1 October 2003, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, United States Army South (UIC: WNAGAA) at Fort Sam Houston, Texas, is designated a Major Subordinate Command (MSC) Headquarters assigned to U.S. Army Forces Command (FORSCOM). Headquarters and Headquarters Company, United States Army South is a multiple component Army Service Component Command (ASCC) Headquarters and is under the combatant command of United States Southern Command (USSOUTHCOM).
