HEADQUARTERS DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY WASHINGTON, DC, 30 April 2004

Redesignation of the Military Traffic Management Command

- 1. Effective 1 January 2004, the Military Traffic Management Command (MTMC) (UIC: W0QFAA, W4PQAA) is redesignated as the Military Surface Deployment and Distribution Command (SDDC).
- a. The personnel and equipment currently assigned to Headquarters, MTMC are assigned to the SDDC, Alexandria, VA.
 - b. All subordinate elements of MTMC are realigned to the SDDC.
- c. All proponency and authorities that currently reside with the MTMC commander are transferred to the SDDC commander and may be further delegated.
- 2. All resources currently programmed to MTMC will be allocated to the SDDC. These resources are defined as all requirements, authorizations, work years, military and civilian personnel, and administrative support staff and related dollars, as well as other resources (that is, contracts, temporary duty, pay, equipment, communications and automation support, current physical space, facilities, fund transfers, operation and maintenance, or other categories of financial resources).
