DESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY TRAINING AND DOCTRINE COMMAND AS AN ARMY COMMAND

- **1.** Effective 16 October 2006, U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC) (UIC: W3YTAA) is designated as an Army Command under the jurisdiction of Headquarters, Department of the Army.
- **2.** TRADOC recruits, trains, and educates the Army's Soldiers; develops leaders; supports training in units; develops doctrine; establishes standards; and builds the future Army.
- **3.** Effective 16 October 2006, the provisions in section II of Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders 1973-16, dated 18 May 1973, inconsistent with this order are hereby superseded.
