DESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY MATERIEL COMMAND AS AN ARMY COMMAND

- **1.** Effective 16 October 2006, the United States Army Materiel Command (AMC)(UIC: W0GWAA) is designated as an Army Command (ACOM) under the jurisdiction of Headquarters, Department of the Army.
- 2. AMC provides superior technology, acquisition support, and logistics to ensure dominant land force capability for Soldiers, the United States, and our allies.
- **3.** Effective 16 October 2006, the provisions of section II of Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders 1962-23, dated 4 May 1962, inconsistent with this order are hereby superseded.
