**DESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY MATERIEL COMMAND
AS AN ARMY COMMAND**


1. Effective 16 October 2006, the United States Army Materiel Command (AMC)(UIC: W0GWAA) is designated as an Army Command (ACOM) under the jurisdiction of Headquarters, Department of the Army.
2. AMC provides superior technology, acquisition support, and logistics to ensure dominant land force capability for Soldiers, the United States, and our allies.
3. Effective 16 October 2006, the provisions of section II of Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders 1962-23, dated 4 May 1962, inconsistent with this order are hereby superseded.
