## TRANSFER AND REDESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY NUCLEAR AND CHEMICAL AGENCY

- 1. This order documents that effective 26 April 2006, the U.S. Army Nuclear and Chemical Agency (UIC: W1YY10, Command Code SE) was transferred from Headquarters, U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command, Fort Monroe, VA (Command Code TC) to the Operations and Plans Support Group Agency (UIC: W1YYAA, Command Code SE), a field operating agency under the authority, direction, and control of the Deputy Chief of Staff, G–3/5/7, Headquarters, Department of the Army, Washington, DC 20310. This transfer included all missions, personnel, equipment, and resources then assigned or allocated to the U.S. Army Nuclear and Chemical Agency.
- 2. This order documents that effective 24 January 2008, the U.S. Army Nuclear and Chemical Agency was redesignated as the U.S. Army Nuclear and Combating Weapons of Mass Destruction Agency (UIC: W1YY10, Command Code SE), with the revised mission of providing nuclear and combating weapons of mass destruction planning and execution expertise for the implementation of Army weapons of mass destruction strategy and policy.
