ASSIGNMENT OF THE ASYMMETRIC WARFARE GROUP AS A SUBORDINATE ELEMENT OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY TRAINING AND DOCTRINE COMMAND

- 1. Effective 11 November 2011, the Asymmetric Warfare Group (AWG) (UIC: SEW6GCAA) together with all of its components, including, but not limited to, the Asymmetric Warfare Center located at Fort A. P. Hill, Virginia, is discontinued as a Field Operating Agency of the Headquarters, Department of the Army, Deputy Chief of Staff, G–3/5/7 and is assigned as a subordinate element of the United States Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC) (UIC: TCW3YTAA).
- 2. The Commanding General, TRADOC shall exercise all authority, direction, and control over the AWG, to include prescribing AWG missions, functions, and responsibilities. The Commander, AWG shall report to the Commanding General, TRADOC as the Commanding General, TRADOC may prescribe. All personnel, equipment, and other resources (for example, contracts and budgeted funds) assigned or allocated to the AWG and its components are transferred and reassigned under the authority, direction, and control of the Commanding General, TRADOC.
- **3.** Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders Number 2, dated 31 January 2006, is hereby superseded.
