REDESIGNATION AND ASSIGNMENT OF EIGHTH ARMY AS A SUBORDINATE COMMAND OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY PACIFIC

- 1. Effective immediately, Eighth Army (UIC: WNDEAA) is discontinued as an Army Service Component Command to the United States Forces Korea (USFK) and is redesignated and assigned as an operational-level Field Army Headquarters and subordinate command of the United States Army Pacific (USARPAC) (UIC: WJMZAA).
- 2. Eighth Army (UIC: WJS7AA) exercises operational control of Army Forces, as delegated by the Commander, United States Pacific Command (USPACOM) through Commander, United States Forces Korea (USFK) or Commander, Korea Command (KORCOM) when USFK transitions to KORCOM.
- **3.** Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders Number 25, dated 16 October 2006, is hereby superseded.
