

DISESTABLISHMENT OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY ACCESSIONS COMMAND

1. Effective 30 September 2012, the United States Army Accessions Command (Unit Identification Code (UIC): W6A4AA) is inactivated.
2. Effective 30 September 2012, the United States Army Cadet Command (UIC: W0MTAA) (including its units) is assigned as a subordinate command to United States Army Training and Doctrine Command.
3. Effective 30 September 2012, the United States Army Recruiting Command (UIC: W06QAA) (including its units) is assigned as a subordinate command to United States Army Training and Doctrine Command.
4. Effective 30 September 2012, the United States Army Training Center (UIC: W6VEAA) (including its units) remains a subordinate command to United States Army Training and Doctrine Command.
5. Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders No. 1, dated 11 February 2004, is hereby superseded.
6. Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders No. 6, dated 1 April 1998, is hereby rescinded.
