TRANSFER AND REASSIGNMENT OF THE U.S. ARMY RECORDS MANAGEMENT AND DECLASSIFICATION AGENCY

- 1. Effective 1 October 2005, all missions, functions, personnel, equipment, and resources of the U.S. Army Records Management and Declassification Agency (RMDA) (Unit Identification Code (UIC) W6ED36), an element of the U.S. Army Human Resources Command (UIC W6EDAA), a field operating agency under the operational control of the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-1 (DCS, G-1), Headquarters, Department of the Army, are transferred and reassigned to the U.S. Army Resources and Programs Agency (UIC W2TZAA), an element of the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army (UIC W1YSAA).
- **2.** Effective 1 October 2005, policy proponency for all records management missions and functions, together with the associated personnel, equipment, and resource authorizations associated with oversight of RMDA and execution of Management Decision Executive Package MU2L, are transferred from the DCS, G-1 to the U.S. Army Resources and Programs Agency (UIC W2TZAA), an element of the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army.
- **3.** Effective 1 October 2005, the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army is designated as Archivist of the Army. This paragraph modifies Army Regulation 25–1, paragraph 2–10a. The changes made by this order will be incorporated in the next publication of AR 25–1.
- **4.** Effective 1 October 2005, the U.S. Armed Services Center for Unit Records Research, an element of the RMDA, is redesignated as the Joint Services Records Research Center.

5. Performance of the above missions and functions will continue to be subject to the oversight of the Chief Information Officer/G–6 in his/her role as the Chief Information Officer, Department of the Army, pursuant to section 3506, title 44, United States Code.
