DESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY TEST AND EVALUATION COMMAND AS A DIRECT REPORTING UNIT

- **1.** Effective 16 October 2006, the United States Army Test and Evaluation Command (ATEC) (UIC: W3Q2AA) is designated as a direct reporting unit of the Chief of Staff, Army.
- 2. ATEC plans, integrates, and conducts experiments, developmental testing, independent operational testing, and independent evaluations and assessments to provide essential information to acquisition decisionmakers and commanders.
- **3.** Effective 16 October 2006, the provisions of section I of Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders 1999-12, dated 31 December 1999, inconsistent with this order are hereby superseded.
