DESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY AS A DIRECT REPORTING UNIT

- 1. Effective 16 October 2006, the United States Military Academy (USMA) (UIC: W1FBAA), is designated as a Direct Reporting Unit of the Chief of Staff, Army.
- **2.** The USMA educates, trains, and inspires the Corps of Cadets so that each graduate is a commissioned leader of character committed to the values of Duty, Honor, Country and prepared for a career of professional excellence and service to the Nation as an officer in the United States Army.
- **3.** Effective 16 October 2006, the provisions of section II of Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders No. 1977–3, dated 10 February 1977, inconsistent with this order are hereby superseded.
