**DESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY
AS A DIRECT REPORTING UNIT**


1. Effective 16 October 2006, the United States Military Academy (USMA) (UIC: W1FBAA), is designated as a Direct Reporting Unit of the Chief of Staff, Army.
2. The USMA educates, trains, and inspires the Corps of Cadets so that each graduate is a commissioned leader of character committed to the values of Duty, Honor, Country and prepared for a career of professional excellence and service to the Nation as an officer in the United States Army.
3. Effective 16 October 2006, the provisions of section II of Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders No. 1977-3, dated 10 February 1977, inconsistent with this order are hereby superseded.
