DESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY PACIFIC AS AN ARMY SERVICE COMPONENT COMMAND

- **1.** Effective 16 October 2006, United States Army Pacific (USARPAC) (UIC: WNCRAA) is designated as an Army Service Component Command (ASCC) to the United States Pacific Command (USPACOM), reporting directly to Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA).
- 2. USARPAC is an operational-level Army Force designated by the Secretary of the Army as the ASCC of USPACOM. USARPAC exercises administrative control authority and responsibility on behalf of the Secretary of the Army and exercises operational control over Army Forces, as delegated by the Commander, USPACOM, throughout the USPACOM area of responsibility, less the Korean Peninsula.
- **3.** Upon the effective date of modular conversion, USARPAC will consist of the following unit identification codes:
 - a. Main Command Post: WJMZAA.
 - b. Operational Command Post: WJM0AA.
 - c. Special Troops Battalion: WJM7AA.
- **4.** Effective 16 October 2006, the provisions of HQDA General Orders No. 2000–2, dated 10 March 2000, inconsistent with this order are hereby superseded.
