DESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY INTELLIGENCE AND SECURITY COMMAND AS A DIRECT REPORTING UNIT

- **1.** Effective 16 October 2006, the United States Army Intelligence and Security Command (INSCOM) (UIC: WOOYAA), which was redesignated by Headquarters, General Orders No. 1976-25, dated 30 December 1976, is designated as a Direct Reporting Unit of the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-2, Headquarters, Department of the Army.
- 2. INSCOM provides intelligence for Army, Joint, and National Intelligence Community requirements; provides Title 50, United States Code National Intelligence Program support to combatant commands and Army organizations; and responds to requirements from national and departmental authorities.
